
1. E-TRAVEL CARD EXPANDS TO DEPARTING PASSENGERS FROM THE PHILIPPINES

Philippine government's eTravel system starting April 15 will be used for both arriving and departing passengers. The E-travel registration now expands to departing passengers from the Philippines. The online portal replaces the paper-based departure card which passengers were required to fill out prior to departure. Departing passengers may log in to the platform at etravel.gov.ph within 72 hours but not later than three hours from their scheduled flight. This process is FREE.

All inbound passengers should apply for e-travel registration before their flight into the Philippines, at least 72 hours prior to departure from country of origin.
